

2012 Rate Increase

During the September 2012 Board meeting the Board of Directors voted for 2% Base Increase and 4% water use increase effected on the October water usage which will be billed in November. Please see the chart below for the existing water rate and new water rate effective in October.

Ex. A Customer has used 5200 gallons during the month, with the Current Water Rate the total bill would be \$31.98. With the October 2012 Water Rate Increase the total bill would be \$33.07. This is a increase of \$1.09.

Upcoming Projects

Starting June 27th, crews will be working on the tank at the Ike Skelton Training site. Some minor corrosion was discovered on the interior of the water tank. The District also is planning on addressing the interior and exterior coating of this water tank, the new coating should have a 20 year life.

After tank renovations are completed at the Ike Skelton Training site work will begin on Tower #2 on the corner of Landry Lane and Route M. The District plans on a total renovation of the exterior and interior of the water tower. Crews will sandblast down to bare metal and apply a new layer of primer and paint. At the same time, other minor repairs will be addressed and the tower is expected to be offline for 6 to 8 weeks. Customers should see no difference in their water service during the renovation.
