## 2026 Spring Flushing Schedule

You should refrain from washing clothes during normal business hours (8:00 am - 4:30 pm) as there may be discoloration in the water. During flushing period you may experience low water pressure. If you have any questions regarding flushing locations, please call the office between 8:00 am and 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday.

The District will be flushing out Well #3 and #4 starting April 13th through April 15th.

Wells #3 and #4 that will be flushed include Algoa Road, Engineers Road, Moreau River Access Road, National Guard Facility, No More Victims Road, North Shamrock Road, Route J from Algoa Road thru Osage City, One Color Way, Partnership Parkway, Steamboat Run Road and Stertzer Road.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank all of you, our customers, for your patience and consideration throughout the flushing period.

### Mowing Bids

Mowing is to include Water District office along with 3 separate well sites. Stop by the office located at 7712 Route M to pick up a bid packet. All bids are due by Wednesday, April 8, 2026.

#### After Hours Voicemail

When you call after hours, the message will lead you through the prompts: Press **1** for an after hours emergency or stay on the line to leave a general message. If **1** is pressed you will be transferred to a call center where you will speak with a live operator. The operator will forward the information onto to the after hours staff members. If a general message is left, the message will not be retrieved until the next working day.

Recently, the Water District was awarded a \$147,500 loan and a \$102,500 grant from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Program. The funds will be utilized to perform excavation on District owned service lines and meter sets to classify the type of piping used and to confirm no lead pipes are in the distribution system. At the March 2026 Meeting, the Board of Directors awarded a project to Total H2O Solutions of Popular Bluff, Missouri to perform excavation work on 232 Water District service lines. During the excavation, new District-owned service lines and meter pits will be installed using internal Capital Improvement Funds. If work is going to take place on your property, you will be receiving a notification from the office next month. The project could cause brief water interruptions even to those customers who were not affected by the project.
